

Nature and hiking experiences in the Weser Uplands

Group Press Trip from 23-26 June 2026


Join a compact press trip through one of Germany's most scenic low mountain regions. From panoramic hilltop views to underground caves, fragrance experiments and unique encounters with reindeer and huskies, this small-group journey offers story-rich experiences for travel and outdoor media.

- **Start:** Rinteln, 23 June 2026, 15:00
- **End:** Hamelin, 26 June 2026, 13:00
 (For those travelling by car, an individual transfer back to Rinteln can be organized)

Optional trip extensions with individual stops, for example in Hamelin, Hanover or Osnabrück, can be arranged upon request.

Note: The itinerary includes hikes up to eight kilometres with some elevation in low mountain terrain. A moderate level of fitness is recommended to fully enjoy all activities.

The following highlights will be visited:

Western Weser Uplands region	
	<p>Hike a section of the 3-Burgen-Tour (Three Castles trail) to reach two prominent viewpoints in the Weser Uplands: the historic Schaumburg and the Paschenburg, situated on a scenic overlook. The route offers impressive panoramic views across the Weser Valley and highlights the diverse landscapes of the Weser Uplands.</p> <p>Explore the Schillat Cave near Hessisch Oldendorf, Germany's northernmost dripstone show cave. Forty-five metres underground, it reveals fascinating limestone formations and geological history, while the neighbouring Riesenberghöhle can be virtually explored via VR to protect its delicate formations and bat habitats.</p>

Holzminden



A scenic drive along the **river Weser** showcases the region's riverside charm, winding through the dramatic landscapes of the Rühler Schweiz, with opportunities for photo stops along the way – including views of the Weser meanders and rolling low mountains.

In Holzminden, the **Sensoria museum** offers a unique, interactive journey into the world of fragrances. Create your own scent, experiment with a scent organ, and uncover the secrets behind perfume composition – a truly sensory storytelling opportunity.

Solling-Vogler Nature Park



Climb the **Hochsolling viewing tower** for panoramic views across the Hochsolling landscape. In Silberborn, experience an animal and adventure farm featuring reindeer and huskies. Meet the animals before embarking on a guided two-hour **husky trekking tour** through the surrounding forests – an active and immersive highlight.

Included Services

- Return transport between the Netherlands and Rinteln/Hamelin
- All transport during the trip
- 3 overnight stays in single rooms at upper mid-range hotels
- Meals starting with dinner on 23 June 2026 and ending with breakfast on 26 August 2026
- Non-alcoholic beverages as well as local wines and beers during meals
- Guides and all entrance fees during the trip
- Accompanied by TMN during the stay (from Rinteln to Hamelin)
- Small press group limited to a maximum of five participants ensuring flexibility and individual attention.
