

Outdoor adventure and action in the Harz Mountains



Group Press Trip from 18-21 August 2026


Discover the Harz Mountains on an action-packed press trip combining outdoor adventure, wildlife encounters and breathtaking landscapes. From treetop ziplines and panoramic viewing towers to moorland hikes and adrenaline-fuelled descents, this small-group journey is designed to deliver story-rich experiences for travel, outdoor and adventure media.


- **Start:** Bad Harzburg, 18 August 2026, 15:00
- **End:** Bad Harzburg, 21 August 2026, 13:00

Optional trip extensions with individual stops, for example in Goslar, Hildesheim, Hanover or Osnabrück, can be arranged upon request.

The following highlights will be visited:

Bad Harzburg	
	<p>As the gateway to the Harz National Park, Bad Harzburg combines nature, adventure and wildlife experiences. The Burgberg cable car takes visitors up to Burgberg hill, followed by a fast yet forest-focused descent on the Baumschwebbahn (treetop zipline) through the forest canopy. The Baumwipfelpfad (treetop path) offers elevated forest views while providing insight into the region's flora and fauna.</p>
	<p>A gentle hike leads to the Rabenklippen, home to the Harz Lynx project. Participants learn about the reintroduction of the elusive Eurasian lynx to the Harz region and can witness the public lynx feeding at the enclosure – a visually compelling wildlife moment for editorial features.</p>

<h2>Torfhaus</h2>	
	<p>At 812 metres above sea level, Torfhaus is the highest settlement in Niedersachsen. A visit to the Harzturm is a must: the 65-metre-high tower with its spectacular spiral design and skywalk provides panoramic views of the Harz Mountains. For thrill-seekers, the integrated slide offers a fun and adrenaline-filled descent.</p> <p>A guided circular walk through the Torfhausmoor introduces participants to the unique moorland ecosystem. Expert guides explain the current forest conditions and the conservation philosophy of the Harz National Park – a great angle for environmental and outdoor reporting.</p>

<h2>Braunlage</h2>	
	<p>In Braunlage, a cable car ride takes participants up to the Wurmberg, the highest peak in Niedersachsen at 971 metres with expansive views across the Harz landscape. The descent on Monster Scooters offers an active, entertaining way back down into the valley, giving a different perspective on the mountain terrain and a fun, visual hook for media coverage.</p>

Included Services

- Return transport between the Netherlands and Bad Harzburg
- All transport during the trip
- 3 overnight stays in single rooms at upper mid-range hotels
- Meals starting with dinner on 18 August 2026 and ending with breakfast on 21 August 2026
- Non-alcoholic beverages as well as local wines and beers during meals
- Guides and all entrance fees during the trip
- Accompanied by TMN during the stay (from/to Bad Harzburg)
- Small press group limited to a maximum of five participants ensuring flexibility and individual attention.
